

## **ITEMS TO GATHER AND BRING TO MEETING WITH THE BANKRUPTCY ATTORNEY**

The first four are on forms you download from my *Boardmanbankruptcy.com* web site.

1. First Interview Sheet;
2. Creditors List;
3. Real & Personal Property List;
4. Court Required “Section 342 Notice”;
5. Tax returns for the last two years;
6. Evidence of all income can be gotten together after we meet, but will be required and includes:
  - a. Paycheck stubs for the last six months;
  - b. Other evidence of all other income for last six months, including gifts and loans from all sources including family members;
7. Certificate of completion of credit counseling. This proves that you have taken the first class. Access the class providers from my Boardmanbankruptcy.com web site page titled: “Educate Yourself About Bankruptcy” or directly from the Government website:
